The Governing Body reserves the right to apply a charge for the following activities.

Residential Activities

Parents are normally expected to meet the full charge where the majority of the time on the residential would be outside of normal school hours 8.45-3.30 on week days. The school will consider, where appropriate, making payment in full or part for children from families where genuine hardship can be proven for the year 6 residential visit.

Lost Equipment / Books etc.

Parents are expected to replace, or meet the cost of replacing, lost items of school property.

Damage / Breakages

Wilful or malicious damage to school buildings or property will be charged to parents.

Photocopying

A charge will be made for all private photocopying:

- A4 black and white 2p per copy
- A4 colour 5p per copy
- A3 black and white 4p per copy
- A3 colour 7p per copy

Other consumables to be charged at the appropriate rate (these charges may fluctuate slightly to take into account price increases)

Laminating – A4 – 20p each
