



Pottery School Uniform

It is our policy that all children wear uniform when attending school, or when participating in school organised events outside normal school hours.

The uniform is available from "[Price & Buckland](#)". This uniform comes with an embroidered school logo and can be delivered either to the purchaser's home or into school.

It is not compulsory to purchase school uniform with a logo. The majority of necessary items are also available from local shops including supermarkets.

Parents

It is one of the responsibilities of parents to ensure that their child has the correct uniform and PE kit, and that it is clean, in good repair and that the child's name is written on all items.

Children who arrive at school wearing non-school uniform clothing will be loaned an appropriate item where possible. Parents will be contacted via letter or text message to broach the matter.

Bottles

Pupils should bring an appropriate bottle filled with water each day into school. This should be a named bottle with a sports cap and have a maximum capacity of 500ml.

Bags

Reception – Year 2: Children should bring a book bag containing their reading book, reading record, a named drinks bottle. **Year 3 – Year 6:** Children should bring a book bag or small rucksack containing their reading book, reading record, a named drinks bottle and healthy snack.

Ear-Rings

Ear-Ring studs are permitted in pierced ears. These should not be worn on PE days and will have to be removed by children before taking part in any physical activities. For those with newly pierced ears, a retainer should be worn for the period that ear-rings should not be removed. We ask that, when possible, parents plan to pierce ears during the summer holidays, to give them time to heal.

Make up and Nails

Make up should not be worn to school.

We ask that pupils do not wear nail varnish when at school. Pupils are also not allowed to wear any form of false nail or gel.

School Uniform List

All children (Reception – Year 6) should choose from:

- Navy blue sweatshirt / cardigan or zip-up hoodie
- Plain white polo shirt
- Plain grey trousers or shorts / skirt or pinafore
- Blue gingham dress
- Grey or white socks
- Grey tights
- Shoes should be flat, black and appropriate for school. If trainers are worn these should be plain black and without obvious logos. Your child should wear shoes which he or she can put on and fasten independently.

In addition, zip-up coats are available from the online store.

For PE all children (Reception – Year 6) should have:

- Plain white round neck t-shirt
- Navy PE shorts or navy track-suit bottoms
- White socks
- Black trainers with no logos – Velcro fastenings are appropriate for children who are struggling with laces

Items marked with a above, which have the embroidered school logo, will soon be available to be purchased from an online retailer.

All children may bring a very small rucksack, preferably a drawstring bag, with their sports kit in on the days they are attending an afterschool sports club.
